Take I-435 West toward Lawrence. Exit on Hwy. K-10 and follow the signs towards Lawrence. Exit on Kill Creek Road in DeSoto, turn right (north). At the stop sign (83rd Street) turn left for appox. 1 block. At the fork, take the right exit, staying on 83rd street. Turn right onto Wyandotte street (3 - 4 blocks). At the stop sign County road 26 (Golden Road), turn left. Proceed approx. 2.5 miles. After a sharp right curve in the road, the entrance to Tall Oaks is on the right.
